ABOUT US

Triathlon Victoria (TV) is the official body responsible for the management and delivery of triathlon, duathlon, aquathlon and multisport within Victoria, TV has ~3,000 members across 44 clubs and is affiliated with Triathlon Australia. We work to ensure that “all Victorians have the opportunity to experience the challenge and joy of multisport”.

TV purpose is to grow, strengthen and connect the triathlon community in Victoria through membership, clubs, programs and events. This is achieved by delivering on our key focus areas:

- Engagement – A sport where everyone feels connected
- Access – A sport that anyone can do
- Pathways – A sport where everyone has the opportunity to achieve
- Clubs – A sport of thriving clubs and communities

POSITION SPECIFICS

Fixed Contract role to deliver the TRI2gether program in schools (allocated geographical region). Remuneration of up to \$2500 dependent on the size of the region and number of schools engaged.

TRI2gether aims to increase physical activity amongst less active 12-17 year-olds. Focussing on “**finish lines, not finish times**” the program supports young people, of all backgrounds and abilities, to look at their performance with an achievement mindset, not through the lens of competition. Aligning to the changing sporting landscape, TRI2gether brings the challenge of multi-sport to those looking for something beyond traditional sport, building skills in swim, bike, run and the confidence to make physical activity part of their lifestyle.

POSITION SUMMARY

The role will support delivery of the TRI2gether program in local secondary schools within the coach/ambassador’s defined geographical area.

Ambassadors are fully supported with curriculum, resources, marketing, etc and act in an ‘on the ground’ role which focuses on:

- Delivering the TRI2gether program and TRI2gether events
- Supporting teachers to deliver the TRI2gether program and enhancing the capability and capacity of schools to embed triathlon into their curriculum or extra-curricular program
- Contributing to the ongoing development of TRI2gether through sharing experiences, refining content, considering new approaches, etc.
- Promoting ongoing participation in triathlon by linking participation to events.
