

# 2019 NISSAN CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

The Moreton Bay Triathlon will host the 2019 Nissan Club Championships.

## 1 Definition

For the purposes of this competition 'Club' is defined as: 'any recognised member body which is affiliated to Triathlon Queensland and is financial for the 2018/19 season and has a minimum of 15 members.

## 2 Eligibility

The only event where points can be earned for the Nissan Club Championships is the Moreton Bay Triathlon, to be held at Pelican Park, Clontarf, Queensland on Sunday, 14 April 2019.

Only financial Competing Club Members of Triathlon Australia for the 2018/19 season are eligible to earn points for their club, with the exception for Non-Competing members who officiate at the event. This does not include members who hold a Non-Competing membership.

Participants purchasing a One Day Membership are ineligible to earn points for any nominated club. Participants in the TBYB programme who haven't converted to an Annual Membership are ineligible to earn points for their club.

Participants need to nominate their club on their registration form for the Moreton Bay Triathlon. The nominated club will be the ONLY club the individual can earn points for in the Nissan Club Championships. Participants will be responsible for notifying Triathlon Queensland of their club affiliation no later than midday, Thursday 11 April 2019. It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that they have declared the correct club.

## 3 Point Allocations

Points are allocated to the participant's nominated club and are not tallied against the individual themselves. An individual can earn points for competing in one wave only and this would be the first entered wave of the day and not any other waves subsequently entered.

Participation points will be allocated as follows:

- a) One (1) participation point will be allocated to each eligible participant's nominated club, for competing in any of the following races; Olympic Distance Triathlon, Sprint Triathlon, Enticer Triathlon, Kool Kids Triathlon.
- b) One (1) participation point will be allocated to each eligible team's nominated club, for participating in the Olympic Distance Team Triathlon and Sprint Team Triathlon. In order for your team to earn a participation point in these events, you must have a minimum of two affiliated members from your team's club.
- c) One (1) participation point will be allocated to each Technical Official's nominated club, for officiating at the Moreton Bay Triathlon.

Competition points will be allocated as follows:

- d) Allocated to eligible to Triathlon Queensland club members only.
- e) Competition points will be allocated in each Age Category as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> = 15pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 14 pts ... 15<sup>th</sup> = 1 point

- f) To earn competition points athletes must race in the distance and category specified in the table below for their Age Group. See Points Matrix below for guide.

- g) Age Group categories and points will be based on the confirmed Triathlon Queensland club members taking part in the race as of COB Thursday, 11 April 2019. I.e. If you wish to earn points you must be entered in the race before this date.
- h) Age Group category point allocation will not be affected by athletes who do not race or do not complete the course.
- i) A club will lose one participation point when a competitor belonging to that club is disqualified from any race.
- j) Points will only be allocated once all race day information has been verified and final results are posted. Athletes will have 20 minutes after the posted time of provisional results to notify a Triathlon Queensland staff member, of changes to the results otherwise the results will stand.
- k) The Olympic Distance Triathlon is a State Championship event, therefore competitors 16 years and over must race in the Olympic Distance event if they wish to take part in the State Championships.
- l) Teams in the Team Triathlon event must have at least 2 members from the same club in the team in order to collect a participation point for their club.

## 5 Nissan Club Championships Awards & Prizes

### Small Club Champions

The club with 50 members or less which has accumulated the most points at the end of the championships will be awarded the title of 2019 Small Club Champions. The Small Club Champions will receive the following prize monies.

- 1<sup>st</sup> = \$500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = \$300
- 3<sup>rd</sup> = \$200

### Medium Club Champions

The club with 51 to 120 members which has accumulated the most points at the end of the championships will be awarded the title of 2019 Medium Club Champions. The Medium Club Champions will receive the following prize monies.

- 1<sup>st</sup> = \$1,000
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = \$600
- 3<sup>rd</sup> = \$400

### Large Club Champions

The club with more than 120 members which has accumulated the most points will be awarded the title of 2019 Large Club Champions. The Large Club Champions will receive the following prize monies.

- 1<sup>st</sup> = \$1,500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = \$1,000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> = \$500

### Aggregate Club Champions

This is awarded to three clubs with the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> highest aggregate scores, calculated by dividing the overall club points by the amount of registered club members as per the Triathlon Australia Membership System as of midday Thursday, 11 April 2019. This excludes those who are registered as Non-Competing members.

Aggregate Club Champions will receive the following prize monies:

- 1<sup>st</sup> - \$1,500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$1,000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$500

The final results of the Nissan Club Championships will be independently audited. The audited results will determine final winners of the Club Championships and no further correspondence will be entered into, in relation to the prize and awards.
