# Athletes may seek selection in one or more events at the 2021 WT Age Group Multisport World Championships. Athletes may not be selected in both the Aquabike and Long-Distance Triathlon at the 2021 WT Age Group Multisport World Championships as these events are run at the same time.

**Team:** 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team

**2021 WT Age Group Multisport World Championships Location:** Almere, Netherlands

**2021 WT Age Group Multisport World Championships Date:** 3<sup>rd</sup> of September to the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2021.

**Important Note 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Selection:**

The 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multisport World Championships are scheduled to occur in Almere the Netherlands from the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September until the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2021. Due to the challenging and ever-changing global health pandemic this event may be postponed or cancelled at a later date. The Australian Government has a current ban on international travel for all Australian citizens and this ban may be in place for some time. Australian age group athletes may not be able to leave Australia to attend the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multisport Team World Championships due to Australian Government travel bans which may be in place for all Australian citizens at such time. Triathlon Australia urges all Australian age group athletes to consider the current global climate including health risks, potential event postponements/cancellations, Australian Government international travel bans when deciding to undertake potential selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team.

Athletes should also be aware that the WT and or the local organising committees in Almere may require event participants to undertake pre-travel and pre-event health checks and to comply with health and safety directions at the event.

Triathlon Australia at its discretion may not select a 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team to attend the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multisport World Championships for reasons including but not limited to Australian Government international travel restrictions and health risks to athletes. Triathlon Australia shall not be responsible or liable in any way to anyone for any consequence of a decision not to select a 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team.

### A. INTERPRETATION

**2021 WT MSWC** means the World Triathlon Multi Sport World Championships owned and sanctioned by World Triathlon to be conducted in Almere, Netherlands from the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September to the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2021.

**Athlete** means an athlete who registers for and competes in one or more event(s).

**2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Athlete Agreement** means a contractual agreement between Triathlon Australia and the athlete which sets out the rights, entitlements and obligations of the athlete having agreed to become a member of the team and the rights, entitlements and obligations of Triathlon Australia in its management and control of the sport and the team.

**CEO** means the person appointed to the position of Chief Executive Officer of Triathlon Australia by Triathlon Australia or her nominee.

**WT** means World Triathlon and is the official governing body for the Olympic sport of Triathlon.

**Relevant Triathlon Australia Membership** means a current annual Triathlon Australia membership in the full Adult, Family, Junior or Coach categories but excludes all Non-Competing/Non-training membership categories.

**Selection Event(s)** means one or more of the age group Multi-Sport events set out in Clause D.

**Selection Points** means the accumulated points calculated and awarded to an athlete who meets the eligibility criteria in Clause E for selection purposes.

**STTAs** means the State and Territory Triathlon Associations affiliated with Triathlon Australia.

**TAAGSAT** means the Triathlon Australia Age Group Selection Appeals Tribunal appointed by Triathlon Australia to hear and determine appeals under this policy.

**TAAGC** means the Triathlon Australia Age Group Committee appointed by Triathlon Australia to select the team under this policy.

**TANAGM** means the Triathlon Australia National Age Group Manager.

**Team Management** means the person(s) appointed to the position(s) of Team Management for the team by Triathlon Australia.

**Team** means the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team selected under this policy to represent Australia at the 2021 World Triathlon Multi-Sport World Championships.

**Triathlon Australia** means Triathlon Australia Limited ACN 007 356 907, the National Federation for the sports of triathlon/ duathlon/ aquathlon/ aquabike and which is affiliated with World Triathlon.

**Undersubscribed** in relation to an event means that there are less applicants for selection for any age group category at the 2021 World Triathlon Multi-Sport World Championships than there are places in the team for that age group per World Triathlon entry rules.

## B. INTRODUCTION

1. This policy details the process and criteria by which Triathlon Australia will select its 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team for the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multi-Sport World Championships to be held in Almere, Netherlands from the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September to the 12<sup>th</sup> of September 2021.
2. 2021 WT MSWC Race Competition Rules stipulate that Triathlon Australia may nominate a maximum of 20 males and 20 females in each age group category of the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multi-Sport World Championships. Age group categories start at 16-19 (Aquathlon, Sprint Distance Duathlon – Draft Legal), 18-19 (Standard Distance Duathlon, Cross Triathlon, Aquabike, Long Distance Triathlon) and then progress in five-year blocks e.g. 20 - 24; 25 - 29 (Sprint Distance Duathlon, Standard Distance Duathlon, Aquathlon, Cross Triathlon, Aquabike, Long Distance Triathlon); for both men and women.
3. Under the terms of this selection policy, the TAAGC is not required to select the maximum of 20 males and 20 females to the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team. Final team numbers are at the absolute discretion of the TAAGC. Triathlon Australia at its discretion may not select a 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team to attend the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multisport World Championships for reasons including but not limited to Australian Government international travel restrictions and health risks to athletes. Triathlon Australia shall not be responsible or liable in any way to anyone for any consequence of a decision not to select a 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team.

4. Athletes are asked to not physically print the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Selection Policy. This 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Selection Policy may be amended at any time by Triathlon Australia if Triathlon Australia believes such an amendment is necessary because of any change in World Triathlon guidelines or eligibility rules for the Event, to give effect to this policy following discovery of a drafting error or oversight, or for any other reason determined to be necessary by Triathlon Australia. Triathlon Australia shall not be responsible or liable in any way to anyone because of such amendment.

### C. SELF-FUNDED TEAM

The 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team is a fully self-funded. Costs to be met by each team member include but are not limited to:

- a) athlete services contribution which includes:
  - i. the race entry fee
  - ii. the team management fee
  - iii. travel insurance (including personal accident insurance while training and racing overseas). Please note that this does not include bike insurance.
- b) the team uniform (race suit and casual)
- c) travel and accommodation, preferably in the nominated Australian team hotel(s).

### D. SELECTION EVENTS

Athletes must register for events on an event by event basis. To view the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport World Championships Team Selection Events please go to <http://www.triathlon.org.au/Events/Events.htm>

It is the athlete's responsibility to identify and comply with the registration rules for each individual event. Please check the 2021 Australian Age Group World Championships Multisport Team Selection Events page <http://www.triathlon.org.au/Events/Events.htm> regularly, event dates and locations are subject to change throughout the 2020/2021 multisport season.

### E. SELECTION POINTS

1. Selection points for events will be awarded as follows:

2. World Triathlon age group eligibility criteria for racing at the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multi-Sport World Championships is determined based on an athlete's age on 31st December 2021.
3. Results from each event will be converted to age as at 31 December 2021 and selection points allocated in priority order per the official race finishing time. Points will be awarded as set out in E1. Athletes finishing in identical time will, for the purposes of this policy, be regarded as finishing in a tie and will be awarded points as in the following example:  
  
E.g. If two athletes finish in a tie (as defined) for 4<sup>th</sup> position in event 4 they will be awarded 21.5 points each (22 + 21 = 43 divided by 2 = 21.5).

4. Selection points will not be awarded to athletes who are not eligible for selection in the team per the terms of Clause F2 below.
5. If an ineligible athlete finishes in the top 25 places in any selection event the points allocated to that finishing position will not “roll down” to the next eligible athlete.
6. If an event is cancelled for any reason, selection points will not be allocated for that event for the purposes of selection in the team. Triathlon Australia will not be responsible for any loss or damage caused by or arising out of such cancellation.
7. If an event format is changed for any reason selection points will still be awarded per the terms of Clause E1.

Examples of an event format change include but are not limited to:

- 1) A triathlon becomes a duathlon
  - 2) The event distance is amended, for example the swim of a triathlon is changed from a 1500m swim to a 750m swim.
8. Selection points will not be awarded to current Relevant Triathlon Australia members if the Triathlon Australia member does not enter their current Relevant Triathlon Australia membership number, correct date of birth and their full correctly spelled first and last names which match their current Relevant Triathlon Australia membership details at the time of entering each individual nominated selection event.

## **F. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. Only athletes qualified per the terms of Clause G will be eligible for selection in the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team.
2. For selection points in an event to accumulate towards selection an athlete must hold a current Relevant Triathlon Australia Membership as of midnight on the Thursday preceding the date of the relevant event.
3. Athletes eligible for Selection

To be eligible for selection in the team, athletes must:

- a) At the time of making application for the team as set out in Clause F3(c) below hold a current Relevant Triathlon Australia Membership.
- b) Not be the holder of a Triathlon Australia Professional License during the financial year in which the selection events conducted.
- c) Notify Triathlon Australia of their Expression of Interest for selection by applying on-line on the Triathlon Australia website by 5pm AEDST on Tuesday the 30th of March 2021.

Athletes must apply for the 2021 Australian Age Group Sprint Distance Duathlon (Draft Legal) Team in order to be eligible for selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Sprint Distance Duathlon (Draft Legal) Team.

Athletes must apply for the 2021 Australian Age Group Standard Distance Duathlon Team in order to be eligible for selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Standard Distance Duathlon Team.

Athletes must apply for the 2021 Australian Age Group Aquathlon Team in order to be eligible for selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Aquathlon Team.

Athletes must apply for the 2021 Australian Age Group Cross Triathlon Team in order to be eligible for selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Cross Triathlon Team.

Athletes must apply for the 2021 Australian Age Group Long Distance Triathlon Team in order to be eligible for selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Long Distance Triathlon Team.

Athletes must apply for the 2021 Australian Age Group Aquabike Team in order to be eligible for selection for the 2021 Australian Age Group Aquabike Team.

For the avoidance of doubt, this includes:

- i) Australian athletes residing overseas who wish to be considered for selection as set out in G4
- ii) Athletes who wish to be considered for discretionary selection as set out in G5.
- iii) Athletes who have gained automatic selection as set out in Clause G2.

**Expressions of Interest must be submitted online through the Triathlon Australia website [www.triathlon.org.au](http://www.triathlon.org.au) by 5pm AEDST on Tuesday the 30<sup>th</sup> of March 2021.**

**No late Expression of Interest will be accepted under any circumstances for the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team.**

## **G. SELECTION CRITERIA**

1. If more than 20 athletes (male or female) register their availability for selection in any age group category, or the selectors exercise their discretion to name less than the number who have registered for selection in any age group category, the TANAGM will select the team in priority order per the provisions of Clause G3.

### **2 Automatic Qualification**

Automatic qualification for the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team will be given to athletes who:

- a) Applied for the 2020 Australian Age Group Multisport Team and had their application received and confirmed by Triathlon Australia. 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Applicants may only validate a potential automatic selection in the individual discipline / distance for which they had applied for the 2020 Australian Age Group Multisport Team. For example, an athlete who had applied for the 2020 Australian Age Group Multisport Team in the Aquathlon event will only be able to validate a potential automatic selection in the Aquathlon event and not for example the Long Distance Triathlon event. Confirmed 2020 Australian Age Group Multisport Team applicants can be found on the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Selection website page

- b) Place first, second, third, fourth or fifth at the 2021 Australian Age Group National Multisport Championships in the following disciplines Cross Triathlon, Aquabike and Long-Distance Triathlon. 2021 Australian National Championship details are noted on the Triathlon Australia 2020/2021 Australian Age Group Team Selection Events Calendar <http://www.triathlon.org.au/Events/Events.htm>.

To validate this automatic qualification, athletes must meet all the eligibility criteria as outlined in clause F of this selection policy.

- c) Place first, second or third in the overall 2020/2021 Australian Age Group National Qualifying Race Series (Sprint Distance Duathlon, Standard Distance Duathlon, Aquathlon, Cross Triathlon, Aquabike and Long-Distance Triathlon) based on an accumulation of points from the best three (3) results from any 2020/2021 Australian Age Group National World Championships Team Qualifying Races.

To validate this automatic qualification, athletes must compete and finish at least one of the 2020/2021 Australian Age Group National Qualifying Series races as listed in clause D of this selection and meet all the eligibility criteria as outlined in clause F of this selection policy.

### **3. Accumulated points from 2020/2021 Age Group National Qualifying Races (Selection Events)**

- a) The Triathlon Australia National Age Group Manager (TANAGM) will make selections in priority order per the highest accumulated selection points based on the best three results in the 2020/2021 Australian age group national qualifying races/ events. For the avoidance of doubt, selection points allocated to an ineligible athlete will not “roll down” to the next eligible athlete for the purposes of selection.
- b) When making selections by operation of G3(a) above and there are athletes with equal number of selection points in any age group category the TANAGM will separate such athletes, if necessary, by applying the following criteria in priority order until an athlete is ranked outright 20<sup>th</sup> on the points scoring system.
- i. The athlete who has competed in the greatest number of 2020/2021 Australian age group national qualifying events in the relevant discipline.
  - ii. The athlete with the highest individual placing in any single 2020/2021 Australian age group national qualifying event in the relevant discipline.
  - iii. The athlete who was most recently a member of an Australian Age Group Multi-Sport World Championships team.
  - iv. The athlete who in the opinion of the TANAGM has the best chance of achieving the highest result in the 2021 WT World Multi-Sport Championships in the relevant discipline.



#### **4. Australian's Residing Overseas**

- a) Australian citizens residing overseas who have not accumulated points by competing in the 2020/2021 Australian Age Group Multi-Sport National Qualifying Series may apply for selection in the Team under this clause. Such applications will only be considered for applicants in age group categories in which there are less than 20 eligible athletes who accumulated points in the 2020/2021 Australian Age Group National Multisport Qualifying Series and have had their nominations accepted. Such applications must be supported by well documented and validated races and results (race results must be between Tuesday the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2020 to 5pm AEDST Tuesday the 30<sup>th</sup> of March 2021).
- b) To be eligible for discretionary selection by operation of 4 (a) above an athlete must:
  - i. Apply for selection per the terms of F3
  - ii. Make written submission to the National Age Group Manager by 5pm AEDST Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> of March 2021. Email [alexandra.fehon@triathlon.org.au](mailto:alexandra.fehon@triathlon.org.au)
  - iii. A written submission must include all matters that the athlete wishes the TAAGC to consider in exercising their discretion under this Clause G4. Such matters may include details of any injury or illness (which must be accompanied by a medical report signed by a registered medical practitioner) or any other factor, such as mechanical failure or extenuating circumstances that have affected an athlete's performance in any relevant event.

#### **5. Discretionary Selections**

- a) In any category where there are less than 20 eligible athletes the TAAGC may at its discretion select additional athletes by operation of this Clause G5 up to the maximum of 20.
- b) To be eligible for discretionary selection by operation of 5(a) above an athlete must:
  - i. Apply for selection per the terms of Clause F3
  - ii. Make written submission to the National Age Group Manager by 5pm AEDST Tuesday the 30<sup>th</sup> March 2021. Email [alexandra.fehon@triathlon.org.au](mailto:alexandra.fehon@triathlon.org.au)
  - iii. A written submission must include all matters that the athlete wishes the TAAGC to consider in exercising their discretion under this Clause G5. Such matters may include details of any injury or illness (which must be accompanied by a medical report signed by a registered medical practitioner) or any other factor, such as mechanical failure or extenuating circumstances that have affected an athlete's performance in any relevant event.

#### **6. Reserves**

- a) If 20 athletes (male and/or female) are selected in an age group category, the TAAGC may at its discretion name up to 5 reserves (male and/or female) per age category.
- b) The reserves will be numbered 1-5 and selected in priority order based on accumulated selection points as set out in Clause G3.
- c) Should a team member withdraw or be removed from the team, the TAAGM may replace that team member with one of the selected reserve athletes and that reserve will be selected in priority order per G3 (a) above.
- d) The TANAGM may exercise his/her discretion at any time up until the closing date for nominating Reserve athletes to participate in the 2021 World Triathlon Multi-Sport World Championships set by World Triathlon. A reserve who is selected per Clause G3 above will be required to accept their position within a reasonable time to be set at the discretion of the

TANAGM.

## H. SELECTION TO THE TEAM

1. Only athletes qualified per the terms of Clause G of this policy will be eligible for selection in the Team.
2. Selection per the terms of this policy is conditional upon the athlete complying with the following:
  - a) Providing one of the following to Triathlon Australia at least eight (16) weeks prior to the date of 2021 World Triathlon Age Group World Multi-Sport Championships:
    - A copy of a current Australian passport
    - A copy of an Australian birth certificate
    - Evidence of Australian citizenship
  - b) Holding a relevant Triathlon Australia membership at the time of 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multi-Sport World Championships; and
  - c) Not applying for or being the holder of a Triathlon Australia Professional License during the financial year in which 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multi-Sport World Championships is conducted.

## I. ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE TEAM

1. Under the terms of this selection policy, the TAAGC is not required to select the maximum of 20 males and 20 females to the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team. Final team numbers are at the absolute discretion of the TAAGC. Triathlon Australia at its discretion may not select a 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team to attend the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multisport World Championships for reasons including but not limited to Australian Government international travel restrictions, health risks to athletes. Triathlon Australia shall not be responsible or liable in any way to anyone for any consequence of a decision not to select a 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team.
2. The 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Preliminary Team will be submitted to the TAAGC for ratification and will be subject to any appeals per the terms of this selection policy.
3. The 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Preliminary Team including any reserves will be announced and posted on the Triathlon Australia website by 5pm AEDST Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> of April 2021.
4. The 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Final Team including any reserves will be submitted to the TAAGC for ratification. The TAAGC will be advised of the outcomes of any appeals.
5. The 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Final Team including any reserves will be announced and posted on the TA website by 5pm AEDST Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2021.

## **J. APPEAL POLICY**

An appeal against a decision of the TAAGC made under this 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Selection Policy must be made per Triathlon Australia's nominated appeals policy which will be published on the Triathlon Australia website at the same time that this 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Selection Policy is published.

## **K. ATHLETE AGREEMENT**

1. All 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport team members will be required to sign and comply with the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Athlete Agreement.
2. Any selected athlete who fails to sign the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Athlete Agreement by the date required by Triathlon Australia will be immediately replaced in the team per Clause G6.
3. Any selected athlete who fails to comply with the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Athlete Agreement may be removed from the team and replaced at any time by the TANAGM per Clause G6 and be subject to Triathlon Australia's Disciplinary Rules.

## **L. 2021 AUSTRALIAN AGE GROUP ONLINE TEAM APPLICATION FEE**

1. Athletes will pay a \$75.00 application fee per each individual event/ discipline when notifying Triathlon Australia of their Expression of Interest for the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team selection online. For example, athletes who would like to apply for more than one event e.g. Aquathlon and Cross Triathlon will complete two separate online applications with a separate \$75.00 payment for each event.
2. If an athlete is not selected onto the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team in the relevant event/ discipline for which they had applied, \$55.00 of their application fee will be refunded. If the athlete was unsuccessful in more than one discipline/ event the athlete will receive \$55.00 of each individual (\$75.00) application fee made to Triathlon Australia.
3. If an athlete is selected onto the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team and the athlete declines the position on the 2021 team in one or more events/ disciplines no part of the application fee will be refunded.
4. If an athlete is selected onto the 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team and they accept their position on the team the \$75.00 application fee will be deducted from the athletes overall 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Athlete Contribution. If an athlete has been selected in more than one event/ discipline each individual application fee of \$75.00 will be deducted from the athletes overall 2021 Australian Age Group Multisport Team Athlete Contribution.
5. If the 2021 World Triathlon Age Group Multisport World Championships are cancelled by World Triathlon and or the Local Organising Committee athletes will be refunded their \$75.00 per individual application fee to Triathlon Australia less the Active Network processing online fee of \$3.75.
