

# COACH REACCREDITATION

As part of Aus Triathlon's commitment to safe sport and the National Integrity Framework, annual coach reaccreditation is now open. This streamlined process, paired with the currency of essential certificates will enable continued accreditation for the next 12 months.

## What is involved?

Our reaccreditation centers around safe sport and safe coaching environments. There are two stages that when combined will take approximately 15 minutes to complete.

### Stage 1

Complete our short module on the National Integrity Framework, Code of Conduct and Scope of Practice.

### Stage 2

Complete the Sport Integrity Australia Child Safeguarding Induction Course

## What happens when I finish reaccreditation?

Once complete, our learning centre reports completion back to our membership system JustGo, ensuring you are able to purchase coach add-on membership, and your accreditation is active.

## FAQ's

### Q: How does annual reaccreditation work?

A: Reaccreditation is the process of renewing your coach credential via short education content and declarations around the national integrity framework, code of conduct and coach scope of practice

### Q: How long will it take me?

A: The process has two steps to it, the AusTriathlon education module and the Sport Integrity Australia Child Safeguarding course. To complete both sections will take approximately 15 minutes.

**Q: I just graduated from a coach education course in the last few months. Do I need to complete reaccreditation between April and June?**

A: No. When you complete an education course your coaching credential will be valid for 12 months from date of graduation.

**Here's an example below**

- Coach graduates from the development coach course on 21st of February 2025
- Coach has development coach credential added to their profile in Just Go and that credential is valid until 20th February 2026
- Coach must complete reaccreditation prior to 20th February 2026
- the window for that coach to complete reaccreditation opens 3 months prior

**Q: I've previously completed SIA Child Safeguarding; do I need to do it again?**

A: No. provided you completed the course from an account linked to the same email address as your coaching activities, it will acknowledge that you have previously completed the course, and you do not need to complete it again.

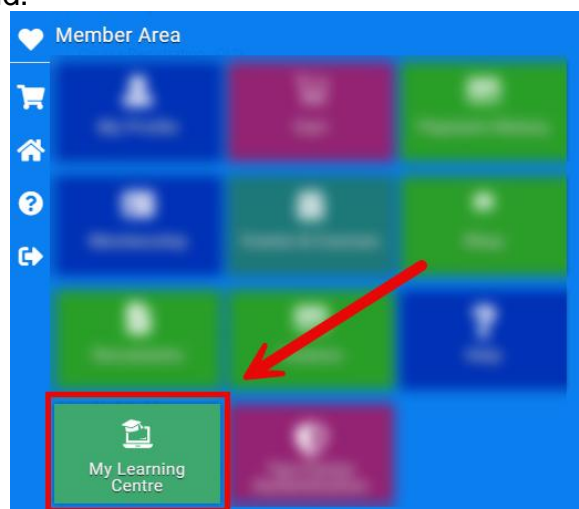
**Q: It's saying I haven't done it before, but I know I have?**

A: If you notice the portal is not picking up your completed SIA course, email [learninghelp@ausport.gov.au](mailto:learninghelp@ausport.gov.au) with your attached certificate of completion and the team will resolve this for you.

**Q: Where do I go to complete reaccreditation?**

A: When your reaccreditation window opens, which for the bulk of our coaches is April 1st, you can log on to your JustGo member portal. Once logged on, head to "My Learning Centre" tile and then click the "coaches" tile.

Once in the coaches' tile, commence your reaccreditation modules at the coaching level you currently hold.



**Q: What if I don't complete reaccreditation?**

A: If you have not completed reaccreditation by the end of the 3-month reaccreditation window, your coaching credential will switch to expired, and you will not be able to purchase coaching membership, and your coaching accreditation will lapse until such time as reaccreditation is complete.
